PAPER...Arches 140lb. Hot Press – *5-8 sheets - 22" x 30" & Ampersand Aquabond – *1-2 ct. - 12"x12", flat panels - **Note: amounts needed will depend on how quickly each student works.*

BRUSHES... Round Brushes - #14, #12, & #8 - Flat Brushes: 3", 2", 1", & ½ " sizes

Trish uses/prefers Taklon – both Round & Flat Brush - for most of her mixed media paintings. Hobby Lobby sells an affordable 3 pk Set Flat Brushes of 3", 2", & 1" sizes - White & Golden Taklon. Hobby Lobby's Master's Touch Brand are also good & affordable when on sale – all are found in the Fine Art Section

MISCELLANEOUS... White Gesso - GOLDEN or Liquitex Brands (approximately 8oz size)

- Basics: Bull clips, White Artist's Tape, Water Bucket (large, at least 1 qt), Water Spray Bottle, & Paper Towels, Saran Wrap & Wax Paper

- 2 - 3 – Boards For Paper – slightly larger than 22"x 30" - Masonite or White Plastic Sign Board are affordable options & can be purchased at Lowe's in large panels & cut to size

– Do not use cardboard or foam core board as it will warp!

Optional: Apron & Plastic Tarp - to put down under your table - Fun Texture Making Stuff- ie. bubble wrap, cheese cloth, or anything interesting around the house you would like to make texture with – *have a playful mind!*

LEAVES...For this class we will be using leaves & nature as stamps, stencils, & textural elements. Trish will bring some leaves to get students started for 1 - 2 paintings. Students will need to bring additional leaves for future paintings. Students should bring several of the same variety leaves in different sizes of small, medium, & large. Not all leaves will work well with this process & since I teach this workshop in so many areas of the country it is difficult to know what leaves are prevalent. Below are listed some good & bad examples of the types of leaves that will & will not work, to help students to know by feel/touch what leaves to bring. Bring at least 5 leaves of each variety leaf in small, medium, and large sizes.

Good Leaf Examples: any soft, supple leaves – ie, maple, hydrangea, & wild grape vine. Some varieties of weeds actually are great to use as they are soft & porous.

Bad Leaf Examples: any hard, waxy, or stiff leaves – ie, oak, magnolia, & pine needles
